

There are immediate openings on the Respiratory Care Practitioner Examining Council. The Council, which serves as an advisor to the Medical Board, is made up of three respiratory care practitioners plus a physician and public member.

Requirements for the RCP Member:

- Has at least 3 years experience as an RCP.
- Holds a current certificate to practice in Wisconsin.
- Is **not** an officer, director or employee of any association that promotes the profession, such as the AARC or WSRC.

The Council meets 2 to 3 times a year in Madison. Members are paid a per diem (generally \$25) and expenses for meetings. Appointments are for a 3-year term.

At the meetings, the Council considers issues relevant to the profession, reviews applications and administers oral exams. (Note: the orals were recently revised to reflect current practice standards. The questions, answers and references are provided to the examiners.)

The Medical Board appoints the professional members of the Council. If you are interested in serving, send a resume to:
